## AGREEMENT FOR RECIPROCAL MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES BETWEEN THE PHYSICAL SOCIETY OF TAIWAN AND THE KOREAN PHYSICAL SOCIETY

The Physical Society of Taiwan (hereafter, TPS) agrees to extend reciprocal membership privileges as defined below to individual members of the Korean Physical Society (hereafter, KPS), and the KPS agrees to extend reciprocal membership privileges as defined below to individual members of the TPS.

- 1. Members of the KPS may submit papers to TPS meetings with the same privileges and limitations as TPS members;
- 2. KPS members may register at TPS meetings at TPS member rates; and
- 3. KPS members may subscribe to TPS journals at the same rates as TPS members.

## Conversely,

- 1. Members of the TPS may submit papers to KPS meetings with the same privileges and limitations as KPS members;
- 2. TPS members may register at KPS meetings at KPS member rates; and
- 3. TPS members may subscribe to KPS journals at the same rates as KPS members.

This agreement shall remain in effect for a minimum of two years following the date below, after which time the terms of the agreement may be reviewed, renegotiated, renewed or terminated if either KPS or TPS so desires.

This agreement shall automatically renew unless either TPS or KPS submits written notice of its intent not to renew prior to the expiration of the current term.
